I am the new development director at ACLU of Utah and would like to introduce myself to you. More importantly, I'd like to thank you for sending the second payment in the amount of \$421.46 for the 2013 campaign. The ACLU of Utah is the only organization in our state dedicated full-time to defending **all** the individual civil liberties enumerated in the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights. Big cases like *Evans v Utah* — our lawsuit petitioning for recognition of valid marriages of same-sex couples — and the continuation of our prison reform work are already making waves locally and nationally.
